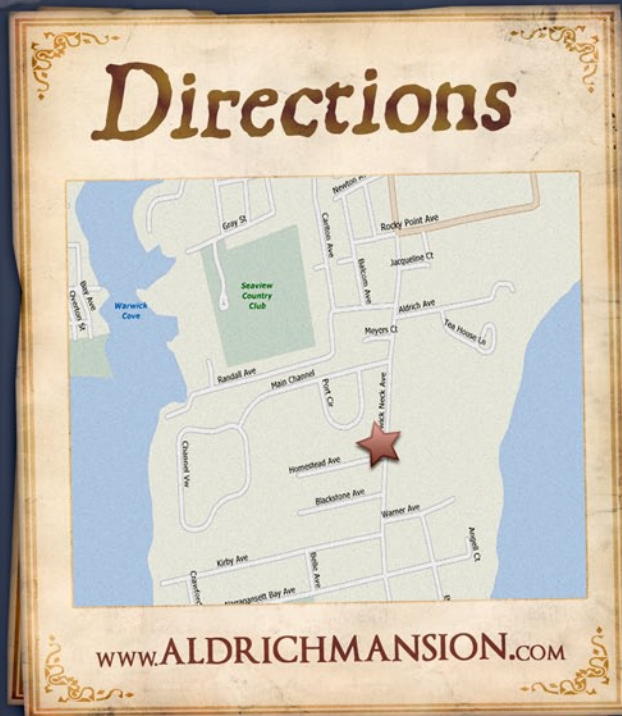

FROM CONNECTICUT GOING NORTH ON ROUTE 95:

1. Take Exit 10 and turn right onto Route 117 East.
2. Follow Route 117 East approximately 5.2 miles.
3. You will reach Rocky Point Pub on the left and a Sunoco gas station on the right.
4. Turn right onto Warwick Neck Ave.
5. The Aldrich Estate is approximately 1.5 miles down Warwick Neck Ave on the left.

FROM PROVIDENCE GOING SOUTH ON ROUTE 95:

1. Take Exit 14 & bear to the left going to Warwick on Rt 37.
2. Take first exit off Rt 37 - Post Road South (Rt 1).
3. Follow to the 4th set of lights & take a left onto Airport Rd.
4. Follow Airport Rd to the first intersection.
5. Turn right onto Warwick Ave & continue to the end.
6. At light, turn left onto West Shore Rd & take an immediate right onto Warwick Neck Ave.
7. The Aldrich Estate is approximately 1.5 miles down Warwick Neck Ave on the left.

NOM Rhode Island's Mission

Founded in 2008 in response to the growing need for an organized opposition to same-sex marriage in the Rhode Island state legislature, NOM-RI serves as a local resource for marriage-related initiatives at the state & local level. For decades, pro-family organizations have educated Rhode Islanders about the importance of marriage and the family, but have lacked the organized, legislative, and political presence needed to impact state and local politics in a coordinated and sustained fashion. NOM-RI seeks to fill that void, organized as a 501(c)(4) nonprofit organization, which gives it the flexibility to lobby the Rhode Island Assembly in support of pro-marriage/family legislation and against initiatives that would weaken these institutions. NOM-RI also maintains Political Action Committee and Educational arms.
